Marcus E. Renfrow, Mayor called the meeting to order, and Pastor Rick Watson led in prayer, and then followed the Pledge of Allegiance.

It was moved by Council Member Hardy that the minutes of prior meetings, copies of which were mailed to each council member prior to the meeting, be approved as written. The motion was seconded by Council Member Stanley and carried.

Debbi McBride, Mayor's Assistant, gave the monthly Administration Department report.

Bills for the month of August 2021 were approved and payment authorized upon a motion by Council Member Loyd, seconded by Council Member Wright and carried.

Mayor Renfrow updated the governing authority on pending grants and projects.

Chief of Police Scott Spell gave the monthly Police Department report. He requested to make Josh Dore a permanent employee effective September 28, 2021. Council Member Wright made a motion with a second by Council Member Stanley and motion carried to accept. Chief Spell requested to make Assistant Chief Mary a permanent employee effective September 2, 2021. Council Member Wright made a motion with second by Council Member Conner and motion carried to accept. Chief Spell requested Julie Coleman be hired as the Chief of Police Secretary. Council Member Wright made a motion and Council Member Stanley seconded motion to accept. Motion carried.

Chief Chris Vice gave the monthly Fire and Civil Defense reports.
