Marcus E. Renfrow, Mayor called the meeting to order, and Rick Watson led in prayer. Then followed the Pledge of Allegiance.

It was moved by Council Member Stanley that the minutes of prior meetings, copies of which were emailed to each council member prior to the meeting, be approved as written. The motion was seconded by Council Member Loyd and carried.

Justin Sittig, City Clerk, gave the monthly Administration Department report.

Bills for the month of February 2022 were approved and payment authorized upon a motion by Council Member Loyd, seconded by Council Member Hardy and carried.

Mayor Renfrow updated the governing authority on pending grants and projects.

Mayor Renfrow noted the addendum to the agenda and Council Member Stanley presented the "Pick of the Pride."

Mayor Renfrow requested a resolution to support the modification to *Louisiana Revised Statute 33:423* – Relative to Disciplinary Authority of Chief of Police. After discussion, Council Member Wright made a motion to support the resolution. The motion died due to no second motion.

Mayor Renfrow then spoke to the Council about interest in selling property belonging to the town on Corporate Drive.

Chief of Police Scott Spell gave the monthly Police Department report.

Terry Vice, Director of Public Works, provided his monthly public works report, and spoke about bids which had been received for the Wastewater Treatment Plant.

Chief Chris Vice gave the monthly Fire Department report.

There being no further business, Council Member Hardy made a motion to adjourn the meeting. The motion was seconded by Council Member Wright and carried.
