Marcus E. Renfrow, Mayor called the meeting to order also led in prayer. Then followed the Pledge of Allegiance.

It was moved by Council Member Loyd that the minutes of prior meetings, copies of which were emailed and given to each council member prior to the meeting, be approved as written. The motion was seconded by Council Member Hardy and carried.

Debbie McBride, Clerk Court gave the administrative report.

Bills for the month of August 2023 were approved and payment will be made upon a motion by Council Member Conner, seconded by Council Member Wright and carried.
