Code of Ordinance Section 15. 4-5 minimum road frontage requirements for lots.

Mayor Renfrow asked for public comment after attorney Cade Cole read the Ordinance allowed hearing none. It was moved by Council Member Stanley and carried by Council Member Loyd to accept.

Be it ordained by the Council of the Town of Vinton that:

That the Code of Ordinances, Town of Vinton, Louisiana, is hereby amended by adding, Section 15.4-5-to read as follows:

Chapter 15.4 - SINGLE FAMILY OCCUPANCY

Sec. 15.4-5. – Minimum road frontage.

- (a) No front foot dimension of a lot shall be less than 50 feet. The front footage shall be along the primary roadway, double or reversed frontage lots are prohibited and the frontage along an alley shall not satisfy this provision.
- (b) No front foot dimension of any lot in a cul-de-sac shall be less than 30 feet and a total area of a lot shall not be less than 10,000 square feet.
