Marcus E. Renfrow, Mayor called the meeting to order also led in prayer. Then followed the Pledge of Allegiance.

It was moved by the Council Member Hardy that the minutes of prior meetings were approved and given to each council member as written. The motion was seconded by Council Member Stanley and carried.
